IPA Seniors Set Record Attendance at Senior Day of Service

More than 65 Irvington Preparatory Academy (IPA) seniors participated in the IPA 2017 Fall Senior Day of Service. This year's theme, "Building Community Through Service," focused on eight student-led projects on or around the IPA campus. Student team captains worked in partnership with the ICS Community Engagement Office, IPA Guidance Counseling Office, and IPA faculty, deploying fellow IPA students to projects including outdoor tree maintenance; storm water drain clearing; winter prep of flower beds; staging of the IPA Athletics Department trophy case; designing and painting lobby ceiling art; and working on the school's student library.



This year's Senior Day of Service kicked off with breakfast and a short convocation with insightful comments from Tim Mulherin, Irvington Community Schools CEO, who emphasized the importance of community service. Following the convocation, the students then broke into teams to work in two 2.5 hour shifts, with a break for lunch. At the end of the day, the students facilitated a "gallery walk" in which all project teams toured the various project sites to

hear from their peers about their experience from the day. The day closed out with a short celebration and comments from all those involved. Each participating youth earned seven (7) Service Learning Hours. And, in total, more than 460 Service Learning Hours were earned throughout the day. Congrats to all our IPA Seniors! Well done!
