- ✓ Book Fees:
 - \$130 per year per student (1st-8th) (discount available for lunch-program participants)
 - \$65.00 per year per student (kindergarten) (discount available for lunch-program participants)

- ✓ Before- (7:00am to 7:30am)
 - Before School Care between 7:30am and 8:00am is free of charge
 - \$2.50 per hour per student (discount available for lunch-program participants)

- ✓ After-School Care (4:00pm to 6:00pm)
 - \$4.50 per hour per student (discount available for lunch-program participants)
 - 15% additional discount on all hours if student attends Before or After Care more than 7 hours per week.

- ✓ Optional Afternoon Kindergarten
 - \$2.50 per hour per student
 - \$10 per day
 - \$40 per week
 - From noon until 4 p.m.
 - Discount available for lunch-program participants

- ✓ Lunch
 - \$2.45 per day per student, includes milk or juice (discount available for lunch-program participants)
 - \$0.50 for each additional milk or juice (no lunch program discounts available)

- ✓ Breakfast
 - \$1.15 per day per student (discount available for lunch-program participants)
 - \$.25 per milk or juice (discount available for lunch-program participants)
 - \$0.50 for each additional milk or juice (no lunch program discounts available)

- ✓ Snack
 - \$.50 per day per student (discount available for lunch-program participants)
