TYING UP SOME LOOSE ENDS FOR THE YEAR: 4th Quarter Conferences are being scheduled. Teachers will be contacting you to schedule the school year’s final parent-teacher conferences. **Textbooks and combination locks will be turned in next week.** Per school policy, the ICS must be reimbursed for damaged textbooks and lost locks. If a textbook is damaged beyond repair, you will be billed for the replacement cost. Otherwise, the cost of re-binding will be passed along to you. If locker combination locks are missing, the replacement cost is \$7.50. **Due to our expansion to three schools,** we are interviewing for a number of teacher positions. This makes it necessary to delay student classroom assignments. You will receive notification in a back-to-school mailer in mid-July. STAGGERED START TIMES FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR: For those of you who have several children attending two or three of our schools next year, please be sure to note the staggered start times we’ll be putting in place beginning August 2nd, our first day in session for the 2010-2011 school year. ICS will stay the same as this school year, beginning the school day at 8 a.m. and having two releases, 3:20 p.m. and 4 p.m. Our new middle school, ICMS, will begin classes at 8:15 a.m., and there will be two releases, at 3:35 p.m. and 4:15 p.m. Irvington Prep will get under way at 8:30 a.m., and students will be released at 3:45 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. ICS Before Care is from 7-7:45 a.m.; the first half-hour is billable; 7:30-7:45 a.m. is free. ICMS Before Care is from 7-8 a.m., with 7:45-8 a.m. free. IPA Before Care runs from 7:30-8:15 a.m., with the specific purpose of serving breakfast. ICS After Care goes from 4:15 p.m.-6 p.m. The 4-4:15 p.m. time slot is free. ICMS After Care begins at 4:15 p.m. through 6 p.m. The 4:15-4:30 p.m. time slot is free. IPA will not offer After Care.
