

FAMILY CONTRACT WITH TEACHER

I, _____, understand that it is a privilege for my child to attend the Irvington Community School, and I promise to support you and cooperate with you in our mutual efforts to educate my child to the best of his or her ability. I also promise I will:

- Support the mission and philosophy of the school.
- Accept and support your classroom rules for behavior.

- Discuss concerns privately with the appropriate school representative(s).
- Listen objectively to your comments and concerns.
- Respond in a timely and complete manner to your communications.
- Attend parent-teacher conferences each quarter.

- Spend 20 hours total every school year volunteering, visiting the classroom, attending meetings or events, meeting with you as the teacher, or in any other way the school and I decide is appropriate.

 - Make sure my child arrives at school well-rested and fed.
 - Maintain healthful nutrition and hygiene for my child.
 - Monitor my child's time with television, computers, and other devices that may distract from education.
 - Be aware of interactions outside of school with other students.
 - Commit to study time at home as needed.
- Remember the Golden Rule and treat you, my child's classmates, and everyone else in the school the same way I want my child to be treated: With respect.
